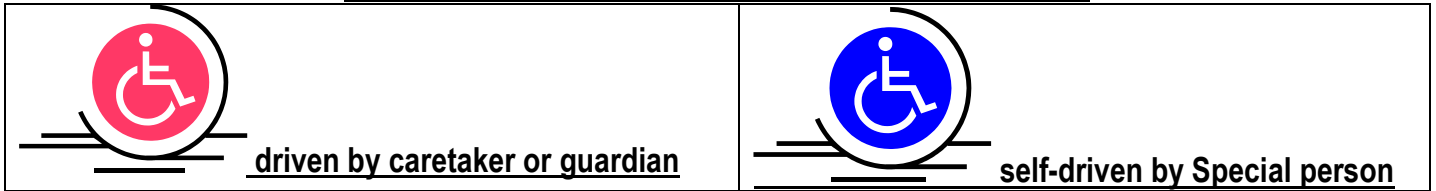


MIRI CITY COUNCIL
TERMS AND CONDITION FOR WHEEL CHAIR STICKER



A. Vehicle owned and self-driven by Special person

1. The vehicle shall be driven by the applicant;
2. The vehicle must be registered under the applicant's name;
3. Allowed to park the vehicle occupying 2 parking lots without the need to display parking coupon; and
4. Such privilege may be withdrawn any time at Council's discretion.

Special person, who wishes to be granted such privilege, is required to make a formal application to council essentially to include the following documents:

- a) a Photostate copy of Identity Card & driving license;
- b) a certified true copy of the relevant vehicle registration card indicating ownership of the vehicle;
- c) a doctor or specialist's report providing information of the physical condition(s) of the applicant; and
- d) The special children/person must be registered with the Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat; and
- e) upon approval granted by Council, **Blue Car** sticker of blue colour depicting "the wheelchair sign for special people" shall be issued to the successful applicant who will be required to stick it/display it on the **driver's door** and on the front and back windscreens of the vehicle in the manner of the display of Road Tax.

B. Vehicle owned/driven by caretaker or guardian or parent

1. The vehicle shall be driven by the caretaker, guardian or parent;
2. Allowed to park the vehicle occupying 2 parking lots whenever necessary only, i.e. when taking or disembarking of special children/adults from the vehicle;
3. The driver is required to display valid coupon while parking at the parking lots; and
4. Such privilege may be withdrawn any time by the Council.

Any person, who wishes to be granted such privilege, is required to make a formal application to Council essentially to include the following documents:

- a) a photostate copy of the Identity Card & driving licence of the caretaker, guardian or parent;
- b) a certified true copy of the relevant vehicle registration card indicating ownership of the vehicle;
- c) a doctor or specialist's report providing information of the physical condition of the special person;
- d) Letter of recommendation from the organization concerned, e.g. Sunflower or Red Crescent Society (where applicable);
- e) The special children/person must be registered with the Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat; and
- f) Upon approval granted by Council, **Red Car** stickers of red colour depicting "the wheelchair sign for special people" shall be issued to the successful applicant who will be required to stick it / display it on the **passenger door** and on the front and back windscreens of the vehicle in the manner of the display of Road Tax.
