

Krokop 10 Market closed for three days for sanitisation works

MIRI: Krokop 10 Market at Jalan Krokop Utama here will be closed for three days starting today (May 19) for sanitisation works.

Miri City Council (MCC) in a press statement yesterday said the move to clean and sanitise the premises comes after the

market was listed as a Covid-19 exposed location.

The council said the market will resume operation on May 22.

MCC also reminded hawkers as well as the public to continue practising high level of personal hygiene, physical distancing and

wearing of face mask while at the market.

Before entering the market, hawkers and the public must check-in using the MySejahtera application or manually in the logbook, and to have their temperature screened, it added.
